#### **COPES**




- Lived experience of mental illness of a family member

- Northpark Private Hospital is piloting inpatient peer support this year
- Even though physically based in MH unit, supervision can be provided by ARAFEMI and/or MH service




**Relationship to Consumer Sept 2011** 






#### **Referral Source Box Hill**

- Differences in physical location e.g. Dandenong & drop ins

- Supervision/buddy systems
- Some way to go to securely bed the role in clinical settings
- Smorgasbord of options eg, peer support as referral hub
- More locations / more settings eg, aged mental health care, adolescent units.
